- A band MAY NOT move down a division.
- Bands must remain the designated division determined by the formula above for the entire marching season. The placement within a division will be determined by the group's enrollment at their <u>FIRST</u> SCSBOA adjudicated event.
- If the number of performing members exceeds the classification numbers declared for that band, all units in the band will be assessed a five (5.0) point penalty.
- In situations where inclement weather or poor field conditions prohibits field performance, competitions may take place outdoors or
 inside gymnasiums at the discretion of the tournament host AND head judge. The entire judging panel will be used to adjudicate the
 music, general effect auxiliary, and percussion captions. Scores from these events will not count as qualifying scores for the SCSBOA
 Field Championships.
- Host bands may perform in their own tournament to secure a qualifying score for the SCSBOA Field Championships and are to be scheduled within their appropriate class. Scores earned will appear on the official recaps. Trophies need not be awarded.
- Band must compete at two SCSBOA field events in 2022 to apply for and potentially qualify for SCSBOA Championships.
- The Field Information Form must be uploaded on Competition Suite to each show that an ensemble registers for and <u>NOT</u> the SCSBOA office.
